Because of her close personal relationship with his Son, the "Prince of Peace", the Virgin Mary has been venerated increasingly as "Queen of Peace": on the calendars of local churches and some religious institutes there is a memory of the Virgin "Queen of Peace."

It is worth remembering that Benedict XV in 1917, while a terrible war was raging the world, ordered that the invocation "Queen of Peace" be added to the Litany of Loreto.

Mother Henriette used it in all difficult circumstances, and to the intervention of Our Lady of Peace she attributed many healings. She had said on its arrival [in Picpus]: "One day we will have our preservation from this Image." The prophecy was fulfilled time and again.

Since the beginning there has always been an attachment of our missionaries to Our Lady of Peace. The farewell of the first missionaries were always done in Picpus at the feet of the Madonna, and they received as a precious treasure from Father Coudrin, the founder of the Institute, a copy of the blessed statue.
